

Blood Quantum [Jeff Barnaby, Canada, 2019, Elevation Pictures]

Starring: Michael Greyeyes, Elle-Máijá Tailfeathers, Forrest Goodluck, Kiowa Gordon, Olivia Scriven

The dead are coming back to life outside the isolated Mi'gMaq reserve of Red Crow, except for its Indigenous inhabitants who are strangely immune to the zombie plague. Traylor (Greyeyes), the local tribal law enforcement, armed with nothing but a gun, a hangover, and a six-pack, must protect his son's pregnant girlfriend, apocalyptic refugees, and drunken reserve riff raff from the hordes of walking corpses infesting the streets of Red Crow. Blood Quantum is the second feature film directed by Jeff Barnaby and is a story intertwined with the recollection of the history of Restouge and the Oka crisis almost 30 years ago.

Castle in the Ground [Joey Klein, Canada, 2019, Woods Entertainment]
Starring: Imogen Poots, Alex Wolff, Neve Campbell, Tom Cullen, Keir Gilchrist

Henry (Wolff) is the primary caretaker for his chronically ill single mother Rebecca (Campbell) right up until the moment of her untimely death. With his girlfriend set to leave for college and his ascetic Jewish relatives ostensible strangers, Henry is left alone with a crippling grief, a burgeoning sense of guilt, as well as an unfinished bottle of Oxycontin 80s... The only person in his life that isn't placating to his loss is his loud, subversive neighbour Ana (Imogen Poots), who has just moved in across the hall. As she tries to manage her own drug habit, as Henry begins to develop his own, the two of them form an unlikely friendship just as they become embroiled in a dangerous situation involving a missing bag of drugs. *Castle in the Ground* was filmed in Sudbury.

This film will join *The Cat and the Moon*, which was previously announced for the In Full View Programme.

All #GenXY and In Full View screenings will take place at SilverCity Sudbury Cinemas, located at 355 Barrydowne Rd. The 31st edition of Cinéfest Sudbury International Film Festival runs from September 14 – 22, 2019.
